Position Summary:

The position also collaborates with Marketing and Communications to promote programs and coordinates special events.

Essential Functions:

1. Assist the Development Department with creating and implementing the Annual Campaign plan and strategy.
2. Provide volunteer support through in-person meetings, email, phone and public speaking engagements.
3. Assist the Development Department with developing and growing our individual donor base; manage the Annual Campaign; and cultivating major gifts.
4. Research prospective donors.
5. Work with Marketing and Communications team to distribute Y program information throughout the community.
6. Planning and Coordinating Special Events.

Required Qualifications:

- Experience in database management.
- Excellent personal computer skills and experience with standard business software.
- Must have good interpersonal, public relations and communication skills including writing, proof reading and speaking.
- Excellent organizational skills and ability to work under deadlines.
- Interest in non-profit work.
